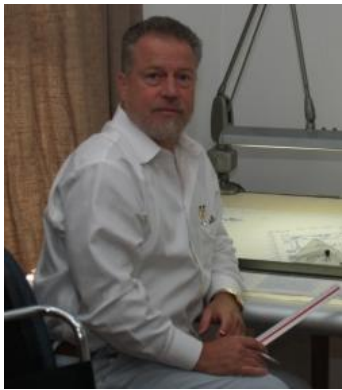


ANNOUNCEMENTS FROM ALAN BELL ARCHITECT
